

WHAT: Lobster Boat Experience

WHEN: Wednesday June 22, 2022, and Friday June 24, 2022

DURATION: 80-90 minutes

TIME: Wednesday June 22nd - **Boat** #1 leaves @ 2:00 p.m. & returns @ 3:30 p.m.

Wednesday June 22nd - **Boat #2** leaves @ 3:45 p.m. & returns @ 5:15 p.m.

Friday June 24th - **Boat #3** leaves @ Time TBD

LIMIT: 20 passengers per boat

FEE: \$25 per person

WHERE: The Wharf is about three quarters of a mile from the hotel, so it will take approximately 15-20

minutes to walk there.

Lobster Boat FAQs:

What should I wear?

First, don't wear anything that you'd be afraid to get dirty. We'll be working on traps being hauled from the ocean floor and it's potentially messy. It can be 10-15 degrees cooler on the water so extra layers are smart. Consider a hat due to limited shade and any footwear is okay. Please check the local forecast and remember if you bring it, you can always take it off.

What if it's raining?

We operate in rain or shine. We do have some cover but are mostly exposed to the weather. Passengers can find shelter standing under the wheelhouse but available seating there is limited. Although we provide aprons, pants, and gloves we highly advise bringing your own foul weather gear.

Is there a bathroom on the boat?

The boat has a low-capacity bathroom suitable for emergency use only. The excursion is 80-90 minutes, and we highly recommend using a restroom in advance. The nearest public restroom is at the Maine State Pier which is 1/3 mile from the boat.
